To avoid large crowds and congestion, it is advisable for freshers to refrain from waiting until the final day of their department schedule for their screening.

**Note:** Female students expecting their monthly cycle which coincides with the health screening schedule, should please undertake their health screening after the last day of their cycle. This is to avoid having to come back a second time to complete the urine test, as the menstrual period will interfere with the results of the urine test.

The health screening fee at the campus clinic is **Five Hundred Ghana Cedis (GHS 500)**. All payments are to be made at the bank or via Momo using your ID number on your Admission letter.
