PEACE

1. REGISTRATION:

- Continuing students are required to pay a minimum of 50% of their total tuition fees to enable them to register.

- iii. Registration Deadline (without penalty) ends on Saturday, September 2, 2023.

NOTE: No persons will be allowed to sit for examination if payments are made beyond November 11, 2023.

2. LECTURES/TIMETABLE:


- i. The provisional timetable for the new semester is available to all students on the University's website:

To avoid large crowds and congestion, it is advisable for freshers to refrain from waiting until the final day of their department schedule for their screening.

Note: Female students expecting their monthly cycle which coincides with the health screening schedule, should please undertake their health screening after the last day of their cycle. This is to avoid having to come back a second time to complete the urine test, as the menstrual period will interfere with the results of the urine test.

Fees & Payments

The health screening fee at the campus clinic is **Five Hundred Ghana Cedis (GHS 500)**. All payments are to be made at the bank or via momo using your ID number on your Admission letter.
